KZN SHARKS BOARD'S VERY FIRST GRADUATION CEREMONY

On the 17th of July 2015, the KwaZulu-Natal Sharks Board Maritime Centre of Excellence will be hosting their very first graduation ceremony for 15 students who completed and passed their Commercial Diving Course Class IV.

These students come from disadvantaged communities in Mpumalanga, Newlands West, and KwaDukuza in KwaZulu-Natal. They started the course by doing an intensive swimming training, followed by First Aid Course, Computer Literacy Course and completed it by doing the Commercial Diving class IV at Seadog Diving School in Saldhana Bay in Cape Town, which they completed on 22 May 2015.

This is one of the great achievements and a great step that the KwaZulu-Natal Sharks Board has taken to introduce African communities into the Maritime Industry, and will continue to do so in future. This achievement was made possible with the support of EThekweni, KwaDukuza Municipalities, and IThwelenye Development Initiative. The CEO of the KwaZulu-Natal Sharks Board, officials from the above mentioned sectors will honour the ceremony, the officials include the Mayor of KwaDukuza, the Councillor of Ward 91 Mpumalanga (Ethekwini) and the Director of Ithwelenye Development Initiative.
